Goldhorn

hennessy vs cognac, cinnamon and orange saccharum, verjus, pineau des charentes, apricot, black pepper

From the peaks of Triglav comes the legend of the Goldhorn, the golden-horned chamois whose blood birthed the healing flowers of the high Alps. Rich fruit, warm spice, and a bright edge evoke its beauty and untamed power.





Frau Kolle

high west double rye whiskey, ginger liqueur, luxardo bitter bianco, pear puree, lemon, vanilla, foam

Frau Holle is a revered figure in Alpine and Germanic folklore, believed to govern winter weather and the cycles of nature. Legend holds that when she shakes her featherbed, snow falls to the earth, transforming the landscape into a realm of quiet beauty.

Will o' the Wisp

havana 3yr and discarded banana peel rum, oregano, pine tree liqueur, honey, pineapple juice, lime

Named for the mysterious lights said to flicker across Alpine marshes and forests, believed by locals for centuries to lead travellers astray along hidden paths. This cocktail mirrors that beguiling dance, weaving warmth from honeyed pineapple and lime with the earthy wildness of pine and oregano.





Mountain Nymph

barsol pisco, champagne and cardamom cordial, fig liqueur, white port, sesame, lime

In Alpine Myth, mountain nymphs were said to bless those who honoured the land with fortune and abundance, yet their ethereal beauty could lead the unwary astray into perilous places. This elegant mix of citrus, fig, and spice captures their grace and wildness.


Lorelei

tanqueray no.ten gin, whole coriander seeds cordial, pernod, mint, lemon bitters

In German legend, Lorelei was a maiden who, after heartbreak, became a siren on the Rhine, luring sailors to ruin with her song and beauty. Cool mint and bright citrus meet a touch of spice - inviting yet elusive, like her call.





Alpenglow

no3 london dry gin, cocchi torino vermouth, pomegranate molasses, red wine, amaro del capo, absinthe

In Dolomite folklore, König Laurin, betrayed by humans, cursed his mountaintop rose garden to never be seen by day or night – yet at dawn and dusk, the mountains still seem to glow rosepink, the famed Alpenglow. This bittersweet blend of red fruit, herbs, and absinthe captures its fleeting magic.
